Piedmont Residential Waste and Recycling Center 200 Owens Rd., Piedmont collects all recyclables, residential waste including Christmas trees.

Homestead Exemption. When you turn 65 you can file for homestead exemption at the tax collector's office with your DL and Medicare card to prove age.

Legal Residence. If you are a resident of Greenville County and the home you own and occupy is your primary legal residence, you are eligible for a special 4% assessment that will reduce your real estate taxes. An application must be filed with the Assessor before the first penalty date (January 15th) for taxes due.
